The Climate Leadership Index (CLI) is calculated every year based on the results of the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP), the most important analysis worldwide that analyses the strategies against the risks and opportunities of climate change taken by companies on the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (Global 500) that trade on the New York stock exchange.

Indeed Repsol was included for a fifth consecutive year in the selective global sustainability indexes DJSI World (Dow Jones Sustainability Index World) and the European DJSI STOXX (Dow Jones Sustainability Index STOXX), where the company has once again proven its leadership in climate change strategies.
