## Repsol gets top marks for a 4th consecutive year

## REPSOL IS LEADER IN TRANSPARENCY ACCORDING TO THE DOW JONES INDEX

- Repsol's strategy on climate change is awarded the highest score in the world index.

- Repsol is leader in its sector in 9 of the 24 categories analysed.



For the fourth consecutive year, Repsol is part of the selective world and European sustainability indexes DJSI World (Dow Jones Sustainability Index STOXX) for its performance in sustainability.

Repsol received the maximum score in the index for transparency, human capital development and social impact in communities, and for the first time top marks in climate change, biodiversity and social awareness management.

Of the 113 oil companies analysed, Repsol is one of 12 included in the index after a rigorous evaluation process that rates its performance in three dimensions: economic, social and environmental.

In the <u>economic dimension</u>, Repsol is once again leader in its sector for transparency, and received the maximum score for brand management. In addition, there is a considerable increase in points for corporate governance, conduct codes and anticorruption policies.

In the <u>environmental dimension</u>, Repsol is leader in biodiversity and its strategy against climate change, and is awarded the maximum points of the sector for Environmental Management Systems.

The company is rated "best in class" in the Oil & Gas sector in the <u>social</u> <u>dimension</u>, with maximum scores well above the industry average in the sector for social impact on communities and human capital development, economic social and environmental issues.

The scores obtained by the company are a result of the development of the Corporate Responsibility Plan 2007-2009, and demonstrate Repsol's commitment to being a leader in transparency and corporate responsibility.

The award adds to the recognition of Repsol in other indices that reward best practices in social responsibility, such as the FTSE4GOOD (Financial Times Stock Exchange Index).



## Additional information

The Dow Jones Sustainability Index is a family of stock market indexes whose components must prove the use of advanced practices in the different areas constituting corporate responsibility. In this way, the Dow Jones Sustainability Index assesses questions such as corporate governance, risk management, climate change strategy or the attraction and retention of talent, among other aspects. Only 10% of the 2,500 stocks, which make up the Dow Jones Global Index, formed by companies traded on the world's principal markets, are part of the Dow Jones Sustainability Index after being subjected to a rigorous analysis and selection process.

Since its launch in 1999, the Dow Jones Sustainability Index has become one of the main examples of a trend known as sustainable or socially responsible investment. Some investors understand that good practice in social and environmental areas are good indicators of the quality of management and governance in a variable income security and, therefore an aspect, which should be considered when building an investment portfolio.
